US TROOPS OUT OF GAZA! BIDEN PLAN IS A FRAUD! UN TROOPS INTO GAZA TO END FAMINE! STOP THE GENOCIDE! IMMEDIATE CEASEFIRE! NO TO ETHNIC CLEANSING AND FORCED DISPLACEMENT! At this moment, over 500,000 Palestinians in Gaza are on the brink of starvation.

The Biden regime plan for establishing a harbor off the West coast of Gaza is a cover for US military action upon Gaza and forced deportation of Palestinians from Gaza while separating Gaza completely from the rest of the Middle East. One thousand US troops are to be deployed to Gaza's seacoast to establish the harbor and a 'temporary' US base. Another US goal is to seize the Palestinian natural gas reserves (said to be 1 trillion cubic feet of gas) which lie off the coast of Gaza. These actions are illegal and in violation of the UN Charter. APIC points out that there is already food and other aid waiting outside Gaza to be allowed in. So there is no need for a special Pentagon operation to bring aid from Cyprus. Civilian settlers, aided by the Israeli Occupation Force, are blocking hundreds of trucks from entering Gaza. The United Nations Relief and Works Agency (UNRWA), which Israel is trying to destroy, has sent most of the trucks, which contain food and other aid. The Israeli government has implemented this blockade as part of its policy to drive all Palestinians out of Palestine.

At this moment, over 500,000 Palestinians in Gaza are on the brink of starvation. "Despite the tragedy unfolding," said UNRWA Commissioner-General Philippe Lazzarini, "the Israeli authorities informed the UN that they will no longer approve any UNRWA food convoys to the north [of Gaza]. This is outrageous & makes it intentional to obstruct lifesaving assistance during a man-made famine," he wrote. Israel has been trying to destroy UNRWA for years and even tortured captured aid workers to force them to "confess" that they support Hamas. This resulted in funding to UNWRA being cut off which is now being restored in light of the reports of the torture.

The American Peace Information Center (APIC) calls on the United Nations to send a UN expeditionary force into Gaza to impose an immediate ceasefire and to ensure delivery of food, medical supplies, blankets, and other aid. APIC also calls on the United Nations to impose a No-Fly Zone over Gaza.
